Covid Guidance Document

Mitchell Minor Hockey Peewee Tournament Covid Guidelines

Arena Entrance:

- Please follow posted signs for entrance and exit for each arena facility.
- Teams/Spectators enter using the same entrance at all arenas being used for the tournament. There are no separate entrances for players/teams.

Proof of Vaccination:

Proof of vaccination will only be checked once daily. You will be required to show:

1. your covid vaccine receipt and
2. your photo ID.

You will be given a bracelet to wear for the remainder of the day that will allow you to re-enter the facility without needing to be rescreened.

As of November 1 in Perth County which includes Mitchell, Monkton and Stratford, all children age 12 and over entering a sports facility when they are not playing are required to be vaccinated and will be asked to show proof of vaccination. This will apply to any siblings over the age of 12 who may be watching any tournament games.

We will not be asking for players to show proof of vaccination as OMHA has a rule in place that in order for players age 12 and over to be rostered, they need to be vaccinated.

Contact Tracing:

- A sign in sheet will be in the lobby of each arena and each individual/family will be required to sign with their name, phone number and that they have passed the covid screening that is posted.
- This sheet will need to be signed for each game that you attend.

Before/After games:

- Please limit time being in lobby at arenas before and after games
- Players/parents/spectators can enter facilities 30 min before scheduled game time
- Parents and spectators will be asked to leave the arena once the game has ended.
- Players and coaches need to be out of your dressing room no later than 30 min after the game

Team contact list required to be submitted by each team:

- Each team will need to submit the attached covid contact tracing sheet for your team that includes a list of your players and staff and contact information. The team contact list is at the end of this document.
- This information will be kept for two weeks after the tournament in case of a positive covid case. After two weeks the document will be shredded.
- This list can be handed in at your first game of the tournament.
- If someone connected to your team tests positive within two weeks of attending the tournament, please contact Mitchell Minor Hockey as soon as possible so contact tracing documents can be shared.

Handwashing and masks reminders:

- Masks must be worn at all times by all in attendance at the tournament.
- Players must wear a mask in the dressing room/hallways prior to games and after game.
- Coaches must wear masks on the bench
- If any person in attendance of the tournament refuses to comply with the mandatory mask guideline, they will not be permitted to enter/stay in the facility.
- Please use hand sanitizer upon entrance to the facility and throughout your time in the arenas. Hand washing is the best way to decrease spreading of viruses.

Note: Please be patient with arena entry process as lineups may develop. Also, please be respectful with arena staff responsible for implementing covid guidelines/restrictions. No harassment will be tolerated.
